

October Seminar - The New Family Law Rules with John-Paul Boyd

John-Paul will provide us with an overview of the new Family Law Act, the successor to the Family Relations Act. The new Act will reshape every aspect of the law on domestic relations in this province, from the care of children to the division of property and debt.

Our speaker practices family law with the firm Aaron, Gordon, Daykin and Nordlinger and is a litigator, arbitrator, mediator, and parenting coordinator. In addition, John-Paul is the author of the <u>BC Family Law Resource</u>, a website, which includes his blog, for public legal education on family law. He also writes for <u>The Stream</u>, Courthouse Libraries BC Blog. He is a prolific writer and frequent speaker on family law topics and is a recipient of the CBA's National Pro Bono Service Award, the UBC Law Alumni Association's Outstanding Young Alumnus Award and the CBABC's Harry Rankin Q.C. Pro Bono Award.
