 Some issues:
 - Some of those who pay by PayPal, the info does not connect to a member, the info is input by an accounting department or other
 - Members are not emailing the membership form or letting membership secretary know the name or email that the PayPay is going to appear under
 - Some cheques are not corresponding to a member no membership form being submitted or membership form submitted electronically and cheque has no reference to the member
 - Some are not submitting membership forms
 - These issues are not all members but extra time is being spent by Ronit & Clare to try to find out who the renewal is for
 - All Exec to think about how to improve the process, wording for membership form, communication to the membership
